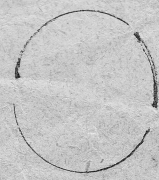

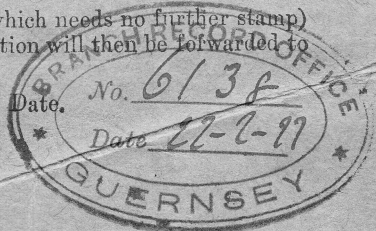

SIR,

I am directed by the Minister of Pensions to inform you that the decision notified on the attached form has been arrived at after consideration of the following disabilities :—

Disability.	Decision on Entitlement. *
Ears Deaf	} Due to Service
" Right Arm	
" Hand	
" Thigh	

In cases of disability, aggravated but not directly caused by service in the war, any pension awarded in respect of such disability will be discontinued, if and when on re-examination it is certified that the effects of aggravation by service have passed away.

Any appeal against the decision that any of your disabilities :—

- (1) is not attributable to or aggravated by service,
- or (2) is due to serious negligence or misconduct,
- or (3) is aggravated by but not attributable to service,
- or against a decision of aggravation passed away,

must be lodged with your Chief Area Officer within 12 months of the date of the first notification of the decision in question, in accordance with Section 6 (1) of the War Pensions Act, 1921.
