*Bridge Building under shellfire.*

*The company were refitted and were moved to Ypres and Poperinge area. A party of them was sent to a place close to Dickebush to construct a heavy bridge to enable the tanks to take part in an advance. This work was completed under shell fire, and two men were gassed. **Sergt. P. Tostevin**, who was in charge of the party received the Military Medal. This was also an immediate award.*
